New Skills Reinforced:

In this activity, you will practice how to:

- 1. use spelling and grammar check.
- 2. use the thesaurus.

Activity Overview:

Upon completion of any document, it is very important to always proofread your work for any errors. In addition, you may want to find alternative words to better describe what you are writing. In this activity, you will use Word's spell check tool to find misspelled words and the thesaurus tool to find alternative words in a document.

Instructions:

1. Open a NEW document in Word.

Note: Unless otherwise stated, the font should be set to Times New Roman, the font size to 12 point.

- 2. Insert a header that includes the activity number and title left aligned, and your name right aligned. Type the header in all caps.
- 3. Starting on the first line of the document, type the press release exactly as shown in **Figure 8-1**.
- 4. Save the document as First & Last Name, PAPARAZZI

- 6. Use the thesaurus tool to find alternative words for the 10 underlined words.
- 7. Underline each of the new replaced words.

- 10. Email file to your instructor. Subject line should be the same as your document name.
